International Civil Engineering Conference (ICEC) is a regular feature in the calendar of events for Institution of Engineers Pakistan and NED



University of Engineering and Technology, Karachi. It is being organized frequently for almost two decades now. Ten International Conferences have been oraanized in the past. Every year, the ICEC is held under an innovative

theme related to contemporary issues that relate Civil Engineering and Socio-economics of the society. The latest version of ICEC was held on February 23-24, 2019 at Karachi. The Conference was organized in collaboration

with Federation of Engineering Institutions of Islamic Countries (FEIIC), Federation of Engineering Institutions of South and Central Asia (FEISCA) and The Asian Civil Engineering Coordinating Council (ACECC). Theme of the conference was "Technological Transformation of Civil Engineering." More than 40 papers were presented at the

2019 conference including those from United States, United Kingdom, Malaysia, Srilanka, Bangladesh, Iran, Indonesia and Nepal. Invited talk from renowned industry experts and consultants were also held to bridge the gap between academia and industry & review the current engineering practices, challenges faced by the industry and their potential solutions in collaboration with academia. The 11th International Civil Engineering Conference is being organized under the theme of "Integrating Innovation & Sustainability in Civil Engineering". The theme is aligned with the fact that Civil Engineering profession has integrated technology from many other disciplines for enhancing its efficiency and productivity incorporating principles of sustainability.



# 38th Executive Committee Meeting

ACECC, the Asian Civil Engineering Coordinating Council, was established on September 27, 1999 in Tokyo, with 5 civil engineering societies/institutes present, namely ASCE, CICHE, JSCE, KSCE, and PICE, to promote collaborative work towards sustainable development of infrastructure within the Asian regions. In the 38th ECM in Karachi, two events are planned by Technical Committees for Sustainable Infrastructure (TC14) & Retrofitting and Strengthening of Existing Infrastructures
